DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1 – 27 OCT: WELCOME TO THAILAND – BANGKOK ARRIVAL - TG643 @16h45



Your trip begins with your arrival in Thailand. Your private guide & driver will meet and greet you at the airport. You will be escorted to the hotel by private transportation. Check in to the hotel and get over the jet lag.

You can mooch through the streets of the city. Historic charm, architectural marvels, and various products are splashed all over this area. After enjoying the first day yourself and return to the hotel for a relaxing sleep.

Overnight in Bangkok.

Start point: Suvarnabhumi Airport Pick Up, Stand 304, BKK Airport, Bang Phli, Samut Prakan 10540, Thailand

DAY 2 – 28 OCT: BANGKOK FREE DAY (B)

Free day in Bangkok.

DAY 3 – 29 OCT: BANGKOK TEMPLES & CANALS TOUR (B/L)

Pick up time: 8h30 am

In the morning, meet your personal guide for a full-day tour of Bangkok. First, head to a nearby pier and board a long-tail boat for a scenic ride down

the Chao Phraya River. After cruising the main waterway and enjoying spectacular views of Bangkok's skyline, you'll turn off into the maze of klongs—narrow canals running through residential neighborhoods. Witness candid scenes of local life as you pass wooden stilt houses strewn with clotheslines; wave to friendly locals relaxing on their porches as traditional music emanates from indoors. Also, keep an eye out for waterbirds like herons, pelicans, and egrets.



The first stop on this boat tour will be at the waterfront temple of Wat Khun Chan. You can't miss the giant, colorful statues of Buddha, deities, and animals. Then visit Wat Paknam, a royal temple dating to the 17th century. You'll tour the museum here, which showcases artifacts from throughout the history of Bangkok and Thailand. This temple complex is also famous for its 226-foot (69-m) statue of a seated golden Buddha—the largest such statue in the city. From here, travel back to the Chao Phraya River and return to the pier, where you'll disembark and have lunch nearby.

In the afternoon, you'll visit two of Bangkok's most famous landmarks: The Grand Palace and The Temple of the Emerald Buddha. The former has been the royal residence since the days of the Siam Kingdom in 1782, and even today it's used for official ceremonies. The latter is perhaps the most iconic Buddhist temple in the country, but the real treasure is inside: a 26-inch (66-cm) jade statue of a meditating Buddha. At the end of the day, you'll return to your hotel.

DAY 4 - 30 OCT: TRAVEL TO KHAO YAI NATIONAL PARK - WINE TASTING (B/L)

Pick up time: 8h00 am

Pick up from your hotel at for 2 hours transfer to Khao Nai National Park, covering almost 2,206 square kilometers, the area is a key watershed for many rivers, has massive biodiversity, and is a habitat for over 350

important rare and endangered species. As such, the Park attracts bird watchers from all over the world. Here, you can get close to nature, find peace, breathe in clean air.

Drive to Khao Yai viewpoint possible to see gibbon and pig-tailed macaque monkey. Visit Khaoyai National Park Museum Headquarters, Heawsuwat waterfall and trekking on the forest trail.



In the afternoon, drive to Valley Khao Yai Winery and discover the art of winemaking – 70-minute visit.

Enjoy the idyllic scenery of Khao Yai's largest vineyard with explanation about the various wine grapes in the estate and also includes other fruits orchards. You will then learn the secrets of wines from vineyard to bottle. And finish the trip by tasting the final product.

Travel back to Bangkok and overnight.

DAY 5 – 31 OCT: FULL DAY BRIDGE OF RIVER KWAI (B/L)

Pick up time: 8h00 am



Say goodbye to the Thai capital for now as you transfer three hours west to the picturesque town of Kanchanaburi. After leaving your bags at the hotel, venture back out to visit the Hellfire Pass Museum to pay your respects to

the prisoners of war who were forced to build the Thailand-Burma Railway, better known as the "Death Railway." Discover the museum's evocative exhibits, artifacts, and photographs depicting the hardships prisoners endured. Then, you can walk along the railway and through the Hellfire Pass yourself for a deeper understanding of the resilience and sacrifices of those who suffered here.

Then, you will be transferred to the station, and take a short train ride from the station to The Bridge of River Kwai. This steel bridge is one of the important historical landmarks and memorials in Thailand. It is almost a symbol of the province and is a recommended place in Kanchanaburi travel guide. The history of the bridge is well known, as it was part of the railway lines in World War II and had seen its share of conflict and bloodshed. After World War II, the damaged bridge was renovated by the Thai government in 1946.

Return to hotel in Bangkok.

DAY 6 – 1 NOV: MAEKLONG RAILWAY MARKET AND DAMNOEN SADUAL FLOATING MARKET – DINNER ON MANOHRA CRUISE (B/L/D)

Pick up time: 8h30 am



Pick up at your hotel after breakfast to depart for Samutsongkram province. Arrive to Maeklong Railway Market (Talad Rom hoop), a must see attraction in Thailand. You will see a train pushing through a busy market and watch as the shopkeeper pull their table of vegetable and meat out of the way. It is a unique and exotic experience.

Drive to Ratchaburi province for Damnoen Saduak Floating Market. Arrive at a jetty pier and board a long-tailed boat ride for about 30 minutes, passing through remote plantations and Thai villages along the river and winding

canal. At the floating market of Damnoen Saduak, it is amazing to see a lively market scene of local vendors selling local foods, tropical fruits, and numerous handicraft products on their boats. You are able to experience yourself in one of these paddling boat and touch the real atmosphere in the realm of this legendary market.

Lunch at a local restaurant and return to hotel. Have some free time in the afternoon.

18h15 – 18h30 – Leave hotel to the pier for the Dinner on Manohra Cruise – Reservation at 19h00.



Overnight in Bangkok.

DAY 7 – 2 NOV: FLY TO PHUKET (B) - TG - 207 | 11h30 – 13h00

Pick up time: 8h30 am


No activities are scheduled today. Have breakfast at hotel, then enjoy free time till transfer to the airport for flight to Phuket. Upon arrival, our driver will meet and transfer you to the airport for check in.

Overnight in Phuket.

DAY 8 – 3 NOV: JAMES BOND ISLAND TOUR BY SPEEDBOAT (B/L) – Group tour

8h00: Pick up from hotel and transfer to Marina.

9h30: Departure from the Marina Phuket direct to James Bond island (Phang Nga Bay)



10h15: Visit James Bond island where “James Bond 007, The man with the Golden Gun” was filmed.

11h00: Start to paddle a sea canoe in the beautiful cave for 45 minutes.

12h30: Great lunch at Panyee Musalim fishing village and free time as leisure for shopping.

14h00: Leave for Panyee village direct to Naka island for swimming and relaxing.

16h00: Departure from Naka island back to Phuket.

16h20: Arrive to Marina and transfer back to hotel by pleasant trip.

Overnight in Phuket.

DAY 9 – 4 NOV: PHUKET FREE DAY (B)

Free time in Phuket.

DAY 10 – 5 NOV: FLY TO HOCHIMINH CITY (B) - VJ808 | 14h10 – 16h05

Pick up time: 10h00 am

Relish the remaining moment in Phuket before your private driver escorts you to the airport to take the flight to Hochiminh city, Vietnam.

When you arrive at Tan Son Nhat Airport, our guide & driver meet & transfer you to hotel in the center of city for check in. Overnight in Hochiminh city.

DAY 11 – 6 NOV: HOCHIMINH CITY TOUR – CUCHI TUNNEL EXPLORATION (B/L)

Pick up time: 8h30 am

Enjoy the sightseeing to Reunification Palace formerly known as Independence Palace, built on the site of the former Norodom Palace, a landmark in Hochiminh City. Our next stop is the War Remnants Museum. Operated by the Vietnamese government, an incipient form of museum opened on September 4, 1975, as the "Exhibition House for US and Puppet Crimes, located in the premises of the former United States Information Agency building.

Have lunch at local restaurant.



In the afternoon, visit the famous Cu Chi Tunnels, an incredible underground tunnel network constructed by Vietnamese resistance fighters during the long struggle for independence. The Cu Chi Tunnel system had been created long time back, from 1948 to assist Viet Minh in the combat with French. And it was continuing built over 25 years later. It was an underground city with living areas, kitchens, storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, command centers. In places, it was housed up to 10,000 people who virtually lived underground for years.... getting married, giving birth. During the American War the entire area of Cu Chi was designated a free fire zone and was heavily bombarded. From 1988, two sections of tunnels have been open for visitors.



Overnight in Hochiminh city.

DAY 12 – 7 NOV: MEKONG DELTA DISCOVERY (B/L)

Pick up time: 8h30 am

Depart from Saigon for the 1.5hr drive to Ben Tre, situated in the Mekong River Delta, exchanging city scenes for lush rice paddies and fruit farms.



At the pier, embark on a fascinating motorboat excursion past stilt houses, fish farms and scenes of countryside living. Arrive at Turtle Island, and sample freshly picked fruit and coconut milk while interacting with a local farming family. Visit a family-run coconut candy workshop, utilising Ben Tre's famous coconuts. Explore more of the Delta from a rowing sampan through a network of small canals. Enjoy country hospitality as you sip a cup of honey tea while taking in a traditional folk song performance. A local lunch of local specialties will be served at the town of My Tho before returning to Saigon in mid-afternoon.

Overnight in Hochiminh city.

DAY 13 – 8 NOV: FLY TO DANANG – HOIAN ANCIENT TOWN (B/D) - VN126 | 11h00 – 12h25

Pick up time: 8h20 am

Have breakfast at the hotel and get ready for your flight from Ho Chi Minh City to Da Nang Airport. Upon arrival, our guide & driver will meet you at the airport and will transfer you to Hoi An.



Coming to **Ancient Town**, spending the left of afternoon for a walking tour around this enchanting port town of Hoi an, follow the narrow lanes lined with centuries-old houses influenced by Chinese, Japanese, French and European architectures and visit its numerous places of interest: the 400-year old Japanese Covered Bridge, the Phuc Kien Assembly Halls, the Tan Ky old house, the local market ...

Then end your tour with an hour-long **boat trip** on the Thu Bon River, which will give you a closer view of fishing boats and country villages before heading to your hotel. You will also have a chance **to drop flower lanterns** in the river. This local tradition has been passed down from generation to generation and symbolizes letting the negative energy go off and making wishes for a brighter future.

Have dinner at local restaurant.

Overnight in Hoian.

DAY 14 – 9 NOV: BANA HILLS WITH GOLDEN BRIDGE (B/L)

Pick up time: 8h30 am



Start our trip to Ba Na Hills, a hill station and resort located in the Truong Son Mountain west of the city of Danang. The station, advertised as "the Dalat of Danang province" by local tourism authorities, was founded in 1919 by French colonists. A trip on cable car will offer you a chance to admire the panorama of Ba Na Hills, spring stream, Danang city and Danang coast from your cabin at the height of 1,487 meters above sea level.

During your time on the mountain, enjoy a visit to Fantasy Park, The Le Jardin, Linh Ung Pagoda, Golden Bridge. ...

Take cable down and return to Hoian hotel. Overnight in Hoian.

DAY 15 – 10 NOV: FREE DAY IN HOIAN (B)

Free day in Hoian for shopping and relax.

DAY 16 – 11 NOV: FLY BACK TO BANGKOK (B) - VN627 | 15h15 – 17h00

Pick up time: 11h30 am

Today, our driver will pick you up from hotel and transfer to Danang Airport, you will fly back to Bangkok, Thailand.

Upon arrival, our driver meets and drive you to the hotel in the Siam area. Overnight in Bangkok.

DAY 17 – 12 NOV: FREE DAY IN BANGKOK (B)

Free time for shopping in relax. There are big malls nearby your hotel - Siam Paragon, Central World, MBK Central...


