

The rules as we know them, as of 1530hrs 16th December 2012 for travelling from Canada to Mexico

Entering mexico.

1. **Fill out the Immigration form before you leave**, this is the form that you hand in to the Immigration desk, the first people you meet after getting off the plane. There will be a man at the bottom of the ramp from the plane asking to see it to prove you have it. You can get the form on the plane or you can fill it out on line and print to show the Immigration. IMM site: <https://www.inm.gob.mx/fmme/publico/en/solicitud.html> if you decide to do this you will first create an account and then proceed to create a form. There will be many pages in the pdf when you finish. You will only need to print out the first couple of pages.
2. At the Toronto airport you will be asked "Have you filled out the Mexican Health form?", this can be found at: <https://www.vuelaseguro.com/login> again create an account and answer the questions to create a QR code. **DO THIS ON YOUR PHONE** so that you can show it when asked.....we were never asked to produce this form.
3. Fill out the Customs form you will get on the plane. This will be presented to the agent at the customs counter (press the button place.. Red or green) after the baggage claim.

It should be noted that you will need to show your vaccination papers at the check-in counter, the scanning lineup and the final passport check before final boarding in Toronto.

Re-entering Canada

1. Get a PCR test 72 hrs before entering Canada
2. Upload PCR test to the ArriveCan app
3. Complete all other details need for the ArriveCan app
